

NSAG Facilitator CE Track

Professional Development

4.0 Hours - 4 Sessions

PREREQUISITE: Core CE Program (15 sessions) must be completed before enrolling in this track.

SCOPE BOUNDARY: This track teaches governance within facilitator scope — environmental design, protocol standards, referral trigger identification, and documentation advocacy. It does not teach clinical screening, drug interaction assessment, diagnosis, treatment, or any function requiring a medical or mental health license.

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The NSAG Facilitator CE Track applies Nervous-System-Aware Governance to four functions within facilitator scope: trauma-informed space design (M1), session protocol governance (M3), cannabis disclosure safety (M4), and documentation advocacy (M9). Each session teaches facilitators to assess institutional structures, physical environments, program protocols, and documentation systems — and to identify precisely when a concern requires clinical referral rather than facilitator governance.

This track exists because facilitators need governance frameworks for the functions unambiguously within their scope. Most facilitator training addresses session technique. This track addresses institutional design.

- Colorado Natural Medicine Facilitators (Proposition 122 / DORA)
- Facilitation trainees in OHA-approved or equivalent programs

- Clinic support staff and program coordinators at service centers
