PREREQUISITE: Core CE Program (15 sessions) must be completed before enrolling in this specialty track.

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

Your patient is on warfarin. Cannabis is not in their chart. This is not their failure — it is a governance failure. Thirty-five percent of primary care patients report using cannabis medically. Five percent have it documented. The interaction risk with warfarin, phenytoin, and immunosuppressants is not hypothetical. Session N1 gives nurses the clinical knowledge and governance framework to close that documentation gap — validated screening, CYP450 protocols, EHR architecture, and disclosure safety language.

Session N2 addresses nursing burnout with the same directness. Maslach's six person-job mismatch domains and a 2024 meta-analysis both confirm: organizational interventions produce significantly greater and more durable burnout reductions than individual interventions. The wellness app won't solve it. Session N2 applies the burnout governance framework to nursing specifically — and then applies Ulrich et al. (2008) evidence-based healthcare design standards to the nursing built environment, including acoustic governance and single-patient room standards.
